Biography:

Marilyn (Rey) Murray grew up in Kansas. Her German-Russian grandparents were from the villages of Beirdeck and Enders in the Volga Region in Russia. Murray is recognized as an international educator, theorist, author, columnist, and psychotherapist. She is regarded as a pioneer in the treatment of trauma and has taught her Murray Method since 1983. Since 2002, she has lived half-time in Moscow, where she was a guest Professor of Psychology and Education at Moscow State University from 2004-2008. She is the author of *Prisoner of Another War* and *Wisdom for a Healing Journey*.
