





Bierock- Also known as a Runza, is a bread roll with cabbage, onion, and hamburger inside

Grebberl- Deep-fried dough like a doughnut and sprinkled with powdered sugar

Zwieback- Traditional Mennonite buns eaten at teatime

Wurst- German word for sausage

Brot- German word for bread

Sauerkraut- Fermented cabbage

Gummersalat- Cucumber salad

Plachinda- Traditional German turnover filled with pumpkin or other fillings

Pfeffernusse- Spice cookies often made around Christmas

Kuchen- German word for cake
